26 On June 30, 2020, the Commission found reason to believe that Hall for Congress
27 and David Gould in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52
28 U.S.C. § 30106(f) by accepting excessive contributions and violated 11 C.F.R. § 102.9 by
29 using general election contributions for primary election expenses.¹ The Commission
30 authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee
