1. Open a Matter Under Review in AR 19-03.
2. Find reason to believe that Ambulatory Surgery Center Association PAC and John Greenwich, in his official capacity as treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) by accepting prohibited corporate contributions.
3. Find reason to believe that Ambulatory Surgery Center Association PAC and John Greenwich in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) by failing to properly report receipts.
4. Find reason to believe that Ambulatory Surgery Center Association PAC and John Greenwich in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(h)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 103.3(a) by failing to timely deposit contributions.
5. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 28, 2020.
6. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Ambulatory Surgery Center Association PAC and John Greenwich in his official capacity as treasurer.

7. Approve the proposed conciliation agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 28, 2020,

8. Approve the appropriate letter.
